


## **Curtis Holder**

**The Makers**Portraits from Backstage




The Makers: Portraits from Backstage is an exhibition by the National Theatre's first ever Artist in Residence, Curtis Holder. The artworks are a love letter to the dynamic creative forces that exist behind the scenes of theatre. The Sky Arts Portrait Artist of the Year for 2020, Holder's multi-layered pencil portraits capture a range of 'makers' at the National Theatre including; wigs, hair and make-up assistants, prop and puppet makers, stage technicians, and a stage door supervisor who has been in post for 48 years. The exhibition highlights all corners of the National Theatre's vast backstage areas, celebrating the incredible craftspeople, creatives and individuals that make all the productions possible.

Holder was originally invited to observe and sketch the rehearsal room for *The Corn is Green* in 2022 and fell under the spell of the theatre. He subsequently became the National Theatre's Artist in Residence. After months of observation and quick sketches, Holder selected a small number of sitters from across the National Theatre to focus upon. At once dynamic and tender, Holder's portraits bring the backstage to the foreground and provide an uncanny psychological insight into his subjects. The works are a testament of the artist's remarkable facility to go beyond the surface and transform the humble pencil into a symphony of feeling. Holder manages to present portraits full of specificity whilst also making artworks that transcend their subject and convey the wider themes of passion, concentration, commitment and fulfilment.















The Stage Door Keeper









The Wig Stylist

# THE CORN IS GREEN IN REHEARSALS
